

WLAN/Wi-Fi at the Collegium

Connecting to the Wi-Fi as an ETH-Guest or employee with an ETH user account:

- To connect to the Wi-Fi at the Collegium you first need a ETH user account (<https://unlimited.ethz.ch/gessitkb/eth-user-account-352316167.html>)¹.
 - o If you haven't set up the ETH User Account yet please see:

- With your ETH-User Account you can either join the **eth**, **eth-5** or **eth-6 Wi-Fi** or continue using **eduroam**.

All Wi-Fi Networks (excluding eduroam) listed above connect with the same personalized login:

Username: <ETH username>@**staff-net.ethz.ch**

Password: ETH network password

Connecting to the Wi-Fi as a Visitor/Guest without an ETH user account:

As a visitor/guest without ETH User Account you can try using the eduroam login (<https://unlimited.ethz.ch/gessitkb/wi-fi-wireless-lan-352316204.html>) from your home university. As the ETH-IT Team has no control of these network logs they cannot help if your login fails.

Alternatively, you can use the **ETH-visitors Wi-Fi** which is a public Wi-Fi and as such isn't encrypted.

² short instruction on how to install an ETH user account (according to Stefan Benz 23.09.25) :

"That you can use your ETH account, you must set two new passwords.

1. Go to the website password.ethz.ch and click on „Forgot your password?“. There you can enter the username "jbialkowski" and a temporary password will be sent to the private email address.

With this password you can sign in on <https://password.ethz.ch> and set a new password.

2. You must activate MFA by going to the website password.ethz.ch/qrcode sign in with your ETH username and the new password, and activate MFA.

3. You must set a second password for the network services like wifi and vpn.

Go to the website password.ethz.ch again, login with username and password, click on self service, choose "Change password", tickmark "Radius" and set the second password."

Pool iMac in the silent pool office B 5.2

In the silent pool office, there is an iMac* available, you can use this iMac as a pool device with a shared user and password:

User: Pool

Password: pool4ch

Or you can log in with your personal ETHZ-User Account.

*The iMac should always be connected to the internet via the blue Ethernet cable.
