Housing for Fellows at the Collegium Helveticum

Unfortunately, the Collegium Helveticum cannot provide housing for its Fellows.

However, in order to simplify this time-consuming search for accommodation in Zurich, ETHZ, together with the University of Zurich, has set up a room and flat agency where (future) ETH/UZH staff, students, doctoral candidates or lecturers can search for suitable accommodation, including our Senior Fellows and Early-career Fellows.

Authorized to use this service are members of the ETHZ and University of Zurich. They can register directly using their login details. In this case, please close the browser window after registration to end the session.

Future members of the ETHZ and University of Zurich may also use this service and can use their Confirmation of Fellowship letter from the Collegium as prove of their employment in step 2.

1. Click on "Register and Log in" on the website

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2. The next step is to register on the website.

As soon as you have filled in the three mandatory fields¹ (marked with a red star), you must click on "Register". Please note that if you haven't received your own ETH/UZH login and email yet, to choose *Incoming Student/employee* and provide the *ETH housing office* with your confirmation letter from the Collegium as prove of your employment/engagement (see next step).
