

Fully hybrid web conference in the Meridian Hall: Meeting OWL Pro

The Meeting OWL Pro can be used for events with virtual participants to create a fully hybrid web conference. This way, virtual participants can see the participants on-site and at the same time participants on-site are able to see virtual participants.

Virtual participants are connected via Zoom or Teams using the presentation laptop (on-site) and can take part in the event virtually. The virtual participants are projected onto the screen on-site via the screen share function and are thus visible to those present (on-site). The sound of the virtual participants can be heard via the Meridian Hall's sound system. It is crucial that the participants on-site talk into a microphone, or else the virtual participants do not hear anything.

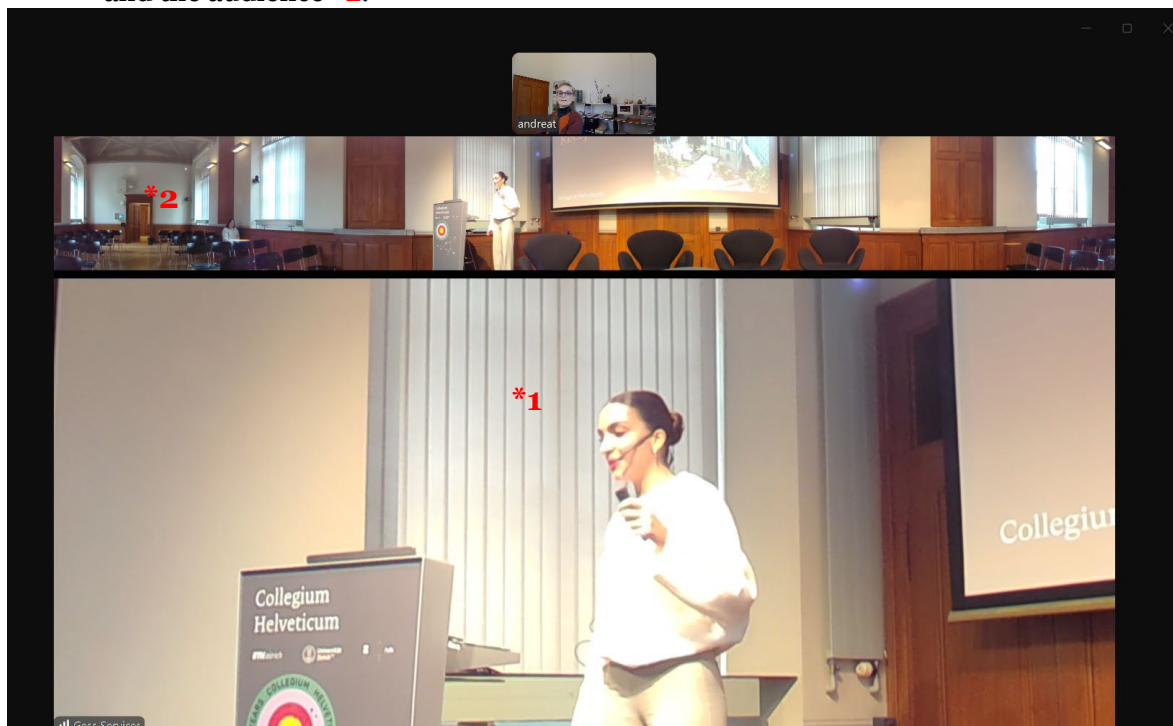
The OWL camera makes the participants on-site visible to the virtual participants.



Virtual speaker's perspective during a fully hybrid web conference:

Presentation: Speaker on-site standing at the lectern:

- Virtual speaker(s) can see the speaker on-site standing at the lectern *1
- and the audience *2.



Presentation: Speaker on-site standing at the lectern, screen-sharing:

- The virtual participant(s) can see the shared screen *3
- and the speaker standing at the lectern *4.



Virtual speaker's perspective during a fully hybrid web conference

Panel discussion, no one is screen sharing:

- On-site participants are visible in a panoramic view *5 at the top of the screen.
- As soon as one *6 or more panelist(s) start to speak, the image is split at the bottom and these people are visible in a larger size.
- The Meeting OWL is convenient for panel discussions as this allows the virtual participant(s) to see everyone involved in the discussion on the panel and not only the person sitting/standing in front of the laptop.



Perspective of participants on-site during a fully hybrid web conference:

A virtual participant is screen sharing:

- The participants on-site can see the shared screen *7
- and a smaller image of the virtual participant *8.



Perspective of participants on-site during a fully hybrid web conference:

Panel discussion, no one is screen sharing:

- The virtual participant(s) are projected onto the screen on-site *9.
